



Showcase ReloadIT presented at World Electric Vehicle Summit 2013 in Oslo

From 14 to 16 May the second annual World Electric Vehicle Summit was being held in Oslo. Around 150 people from all over the world were together to talk about the future of electric mobility. Business, government and knowledge-institutions were presented. Norway is leading the way in this field with over 12.000 full-electric vehicles. Free parking in the city, free electricity at charging stations, permission to use the buslane, and other fiscal advantages pull automobile drivers towards e-cars. An example to follow?

The theme of the third day was 'Urban Fleet Integration', where Tom Groot from the municipality of Zaanstad had the opportunity to talk about the smart grid showcase ReloadIT. During the presentation Tom showed the possibility to live-connect with the system. In this way, Tom showed the current accu-status of the electric cars in Zaanstad, and showed the current revenue of the solar installations. ReloadIT was the first actual working smart grid presented at the WEVS 2013.
